## Ezra 9:8

And now for a little while **grace** has been shown from the LORD our God, to leave us a remnant to escape, and to give us a peg in His holy place, that our God may enlighten our eyes and give us a measure of revival in our bondage.

### **Acts 4:33**

And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great **grace** was upon them all.

When he came and had seen the **grace** of God, he was glad, and encouraged them all that with purpose of heart they should continue with the Lord.

### **Luke 2:40**

And the Child grew and became strong in spirit, filled with wisdom; and the **grace** of God was upon Him.

### **Acts 13:43**

Now when the congregation had broken up, many of the Jews and devout proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas, who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in the **grace** of God.

### **Acts 14:3**

Therefore they stayed there a long time, speaking boldly in the Lord, who was bearing witness to the word of His **grace**, granting signs and wonders to be done by their hands.

### **Acts 14:26**

From there they sailed to Antioch, where they had been commended to the **grace** of God for the work which they had completed.

but Paul chose Silas and departed, being commended by the brethren to the **grace** of God.

### **Acts 18:27**

And when he desired to cross to Achaia, the brethren wrote, exhorting the disciples to receive him; and when he arrived, he greatly helped those who had believed through **grace**;

### **Acts 20:24**

But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the **grace** of God.

“So now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the word of His **grace**, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

### **Romans 1:5**

### **Romans 3:24**

being justified freely by His **grace** through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,

### **Romans 5:2**

through whom also we have access by faith into this **grace** in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

### **Romans 5:15**

But the free gift is not like the offense. For if by the one man's offense many died, much more the **grace** of God and the gift by the **grace** of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many.

### **Romans 5:20**

Moreover the law entered that the offense might abound. But where sin abounded, **grace** abounded much more,

### **Romans 5:21**

so that as sin reigned in death, even so **grace** might reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

### **Romans 6:14**

For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under **grace**.

Even so then, at this present time there is a remnant according to the election of **grace**.

For I say, through the **grace** given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.

### **I Corinthians 1:4**

I thank my God always concerning you for the **grace** of God which was given to you by Christ Jesus,

### **1 Corinthians 3:10**

According to the **grace** of God which was given to me, as a wise master builder I have laid the foundation, and another builds on it. But let each one take heed how he builds on it.

### **1 Corinthians 15:10**

But by the **grace** of God I am what I am, and His **grace** toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the **grace** of God which was with me.

For our boasting is this: the testimony of our conscience that we conducted ourselves in the world in simplicity and godly sincerity, not with fleshly wisdom but by the **grace** of God, and more abundantly toward you.

Moreover, brethren, we make known to you the **grace** of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia:

You have become estranged from Christ, you who attempt to be justified by law; you have fallen from **grace**.

### **Ephesians 1:6-7**

to the praise of the glory of His **grace**, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved. In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His **grace**

### **Ephesians 2:5**

even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by **grace** you have been saved),

**How are we made alive?**

### **Ephesians 2:7**

that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His **grace** in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

### **Ephesians 2:8**

For by **grace** you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, What does grace do and what is it?

that the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the **grace** of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.
